Explorer's Club Summer Camp

Deadline

Completed applications for both Financial support toward Summer Camp and One to One Aide services for Summer Camp must be postmarked no later than **April 30, 2019**. Applications, including supporting documentation, **MUST** be complete in order to be considered. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure all necessary paperwork is on time.

If a 1:1 Aide is required, a separate application for 1:1 Aide Services for Summer Camp 2019 must be submitted to PerformCare. You will need the child's CYBER ID number in order to complete the application. If this information is not known, please contact PerformCare at 877-652-7624

Important Information

Youth are eligible for CSOC Summer Camp Services only during the period of time in which they are not eligible to attend an extended school-year program. Financial support is based on available resources in a given fiscal year. The amount of financial support available per individual is capped and may vary year-to-year and by how many families apply.

Completed applications for CSOC Summer Camp Services (Financial Support Toward Summer Camp Tuition and One-to-One Aide Services for Summer Camp) must be postmarked or received by PerformCare no later than April 30, 2019. Your application must be complete for the services requested for it to be considered.

Camp Eligibility

For 2019, the New Jersey Children's System of Care (CSOC) will be providing Summer Camp Services to eligible children, youth, and young adults under 21 years of age. These services include **Financial Support Toward Summer Camp Tuition Opens a new window** and **One-to-One Aide Services for Summer Camp**. Your child must be determined eligible for developmental disability services by CSOC and registered for a qualified camp prior to submitting the application for CSOC Summer Camp Services.

A youth can be considered eligible for CSOC Summer Camp Services if all of the following conditions are met:

1. The youth is deemed eligible for CSOC developmental disability (DD) services.
2. The youth is under the age of 21 and will not turn 21 before the end of the camp dates selected for reimbursement.
3. The youth resides in their own home, with a caregiver.

Timeline

- 1. Parents or guardians must register the youth with the camp BEFORE starting the request** for CSOC Financial Support toward Summer Camp Tuition.
- 2. The family is required to provide the following documentation to PerformCare:**
 - A completed Summer Camp application
 - A copy of the Summer Camp registration form or a letter from the camp (on Camp letterhead) indicating that the individual is registered for the qualified camp.**Camps must be from the DCF qualified provider list.**

"Please note, while PerformCare will fund summer camp for eligible children, youth and young adults up to age 21, NBN's Explorer's Club Summer Camp is accepting campers ages 4-17 for the 2019 season."
